- Light fixture in office changed some complaints about it being too bright were received so the possibility of getting a dimable light installed will be explored by Donna.

# **KBC** Insurance

- Val has been looking into our insurance coverage needs. The City covers building structure insurance, Sport BC holds our liability component and Interior Savings holds our content coverage. Val & Donna are working on getting Directors' Insurance coverage as well but have run into a few glitches along the way. The search continues.

#### Misc. Matters

- With the accumulation of racquets building up it was decided we need a policy for unclaimed or donated racquets & just how best to deal with these. TK & Donna offered suggestions to be considered and hopefully a workable policy will be developed.
- The issue of too many people not changing from street shoes to clean inside shoes has been a problem. Martin suggested putting a sign up right at the court entrance reminding people of this. We may also consider adding a note in this regard in our next membership newsletter.
- A suggestion was proposed to offer free membership to Ukranian refugees/immigrants. This was discussed & it was felt that our introductory sessions would best serve the purpose initially to see who might like to pursue taking out a membership. This idea will be communicated to the member making the suggestion.

# Kelowna Badminton Club Rules (the "Rules")

- 1. **COURT SHOES** used only indoors must be worn in the court area. Any footwear worn outside is to be removed in the lobby or change rooms to limit sand and dirt on the courts. The court area includes the entire wooden floor, not just the courts. Dirt and debris from shoes worn outside can damage the wooden floors and may increase the risk of injury to players. There are donated court shoes in both the men's and women's locker rooms for people to borrow, if needed. BARE FEET or socked feet are not allowed on the courts.
- 2. The members of the Kelowna Badminton Club (KBC) are expected to be friendly and courteous to other players, members and/or guests.
- 3. **COURT ETIQUETTE** and acceptable attire.
- (a) Members and guests are expected to wear proper badminton attire. Baseball caps are not allowed to be worn while playing badminton. Headbands may be worn to keep sweat out of one's eyes. The KBC has headbands for sale.
- (b) Members and guests are not to walk behind any court when play is in progress on that court. Members and guests may walk behind an active court between points when play has paused.
- (c) Children under age 12 are to be supervised by a responsible member at all times.
- 4. **ENTRY CARDS** are not to be loaned out to anyone, which includes family members. Entry Cards are for the exclusive use of the member. Members are to scan their entry card each and every time when entering the KBC building.
- 5. **COMMUNICABLE DISEASE POLICY**, located on the KBC Website (www.kelownabadminton.ca), must be complied with by all members and their guests.
- 6. **GUEST FEES**. Members are responsible to ensure that their guest(s) have been registered and paid the applicable guest fee PRIOR TO PLAY. A guest is permitted access to KBC building only when they are with a member. Guest fees are payable through the KBC Website at kelownabadminton.ca/kbc-guest-fee/.
- 7. **COURT BOOKINGS/RESERVATIONS.** Members must comply with the Court Booking Policy on the KBC Website.

These Rules are regularly updated and the most current version may be found on the KBC Website.

Breach and/or violation of any of the Rules or above referenced policies may result in revocation of membership and/or other measure(s) being taken by the KBC.
