Meeting called to order at 7:20 pm


Agenda Approved as presented. Motion - Andrew, Seconded by Andy

Financial Update - Anubhav

Anubhav sent financial update reports and this was reviewed with no significant questions. Budget issues to be presented at AGM:

Sink in women't room - It appears the sink is rusting out so Donna is looking at getting that problem dealt with.

Office desk rebuild - Donna would like to get the deteriorating desk rebuilt so will be looking at getting another quote for that job.

Camera system - Will have Miles from Three West Security give us information on cost to add 2 cameras to our system while he's at the club for the Kantech system.

Roof skuppers - Laing Maintence came to the club & cleaned out these drains on the flat roof so hopefully this will prevent debris clogging them causing water to drip onto the court area between courts 4 & 5. This is something that needs to be done once or twice a year so hopefully we can arrange that.
