

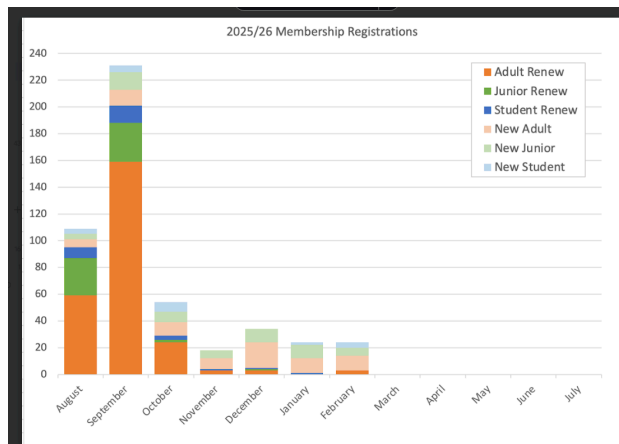
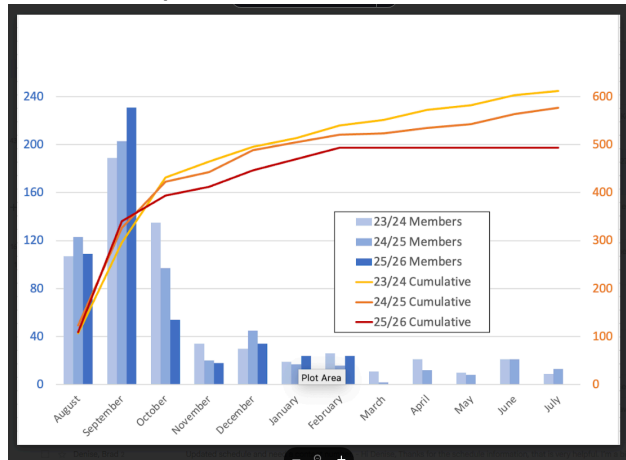
## **KBC Board Meeting Minutes – March 4<sup>th</sup>, 630PM**
